

The three Calls for **Marie Curie Individual Fellowships** are open on March 17, 2010! The Individual Fellowships support *experienced researchers* to carry out research abroad and acquire new skills and knowledge.

- **IEF, Intra-European Fellowship:** provides financial support for trans-national mobility in Europe for a period of 12 to 24 months. Applicants can be of any nationality but must move from a Member State (MS) or an Associated Country (AC) to another MS or AC.
- **IOF, International Outgoing Fellowship:** offers the opportunity to do some research in a *third country* (e.g.:USA, China, Canada, India, Russia, South Africa, New Zealand, etc.) for a period of 12 to 24 months, followed by a mandatory return phase of 1 year in Europe. Researchers must be nationals of a EU Member State or an Associated Country.
- **IIF, International Incoming Fellowship:** aims to attract researchers who are currently active in a *third country* to come (back) to Europe and work on research projects. Researchers can be of any nationality but must move from a *third country* to a EU Member State or an Associated Country.

**Experienced researchers:** must be either in possession of a Ph.D. or have at least 4 years of full-time equivalent research experience after they had formally obtained the degree that entitles them to embark on a doctorate
